Exhibitors must have sufficient insurance coverage for the duration of the show and provide proof upon request. The following outlines our minimum insurance requirements:

The Exhibitor is responsible for the placement and cost of insurance relating to its participation in the Show. The Exhibitor shall obtain and maintain at its own expense during the period commencing on the first move-in date and terminating on the last move-out date, a policy of insurance acceptable to Show Management. The policy of insurance shall name Truck World Show Partnership and its affiliates as additional insured and insure the Exhibitor against all claims of any kind arising from or in any way connected with the Exhibitor's presence or operations at the Show. The Exhibitor shall carry liability insurance of \$2 million. The Exhibitor agrees to furnish immediately to Show Management upon execution of the Exhibit Contract certificates of insurance pertaining to all policies of insurance carried by the Exhibitor together with satisfactory evidence from the insurer of the continuation of such policies. If the Exhibitor fails to comply with any of the foregoing, in addition to any other rights or remedies available to Show Management in law or under these rules and regulations, Show Management shall have the right to take possession of the Exhibit Booth and the Exhibitor will be held liable for the full contract price for the said Exhibit Booth.
