We are committed to producing a safe trade show for our attendees, exhibitors, suppliers, and staff. We are carefully monitoring the vaccination rollout, government guidelines and public health regulations to ensure the trade show will be a safe place to interact and conduct business.

As part of our commitment, we have developed safety protocols and best practices around COVID-19 response and prevention and is being updated as more information and guidance becomes available.

Prior to the Show:

- If you feel sick, experiencing any symptoms or exposure of COVID-19, please do not come to the show.
- Please don't forget, your own face covering.
- The Ontario Government has implemented the [Enhanced COVID-19 Vaccine Certificate](#)

FOR USA travelers, please note the following:

- Download the [ArriveCAN](#) app and store your information in the app.
- You are required to show proof of a negative PCR test 72 hours before your departure date from USA (even if you are fully vaccinated)
- You are required to show proof of a negative PCR test 72 hours before your departure date leaving Canada to USA (even if you are fully vaccinated)

Arriving at the Show:

- *Attendees* will be required to provide proof of their full vaccination (14 days after your second dose) to access the show . Proof of full vaccination can be provided from a mobile device or a hard copy along with photo ID.
- *Attendees, exhibitors, suppliers, and staff* are required to complete a COVID-19 screening defined by the Ministry of Health each day. This will be completed by scanning a QR code and answering questions or questions will be asked verbally if the QR Code isn't usable.

During the Show:

- Face covering **must be worn at all times**. Should you forget your own face covering, one will be provided.
- There will be hand sanitizers that will be accessible for all in attendance.
- There will be signage throughout as a reminder of safety protocols.
- The event space will be cleaned more frequently, and daily disinfecting will take place to sanitize public areas.
- First aid personnel will be onsite and available to help individuals who do not feel well.
